From August 1 – August 31, the following can be dropped off at the Service Garage, 100 Solon Road, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday (NO AFTER HOURS DROP OFF); Sealers, primers, or coatings - varnishes, polyurethanes, shellacs - paint thinner, mineral spirits, turpentine - pesticides, herbicides, fungicides - caustic household cleaners - automotive fluids, motor oil, car batteries - adhesives, roof tar, driveway sealer - kerosene, gasoline, lighter fluid, mercury.

CFL - Compact fluorescent bulbs are not accepted in our round-up, they should be turned in at Home Depot or Lowe's.

No latex paint accepted. Bedford residents only.

Open Burning Regulations

- Open burning consists of burning clean fuel (wood and twigs).
- Burning must be at least 50' from any structure.
- An adult must always be present.
- Fire extinguisher or other extinguishing agent must be in close vicinity of open burning.
- Fire Department has the right to extinguish fire if it's objectionable to neighbors or is deemed hazardous.
