Mayor Pocek began discussion of the Special Council Meeting agenda.


Ordinance No. 9096-13 was an ordinance for a contract with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving for Broadway Avenue Waterline Project at a cost of \$1,509,190.00. Mr. Saunders said he had spoken to Joe Ciuni earlier this afternoon and Mr. Ciuni clarified all his concerns. Mr. Saunders mentioned there were two (2) water mains in this area; a 30" and a 40" water main pipe which could be of some concern.


Mr. Angelo explained the new pavement thickness would match the existing asphalt and when the project was completed, the road would be level. He noted this was a 120 day project and it should be done by the end of the season.

Mrs. Mizsak asked what section would be torn up. The area would be Broadway Avenue; down the hill toward Taylor Street. Mrs. Zolata questioned what side of the road would be affected. It was determined the east side four (4) foot from the curb.

ORDINANCE NO 9096-13, an ordinance authorizing and directing the City Manager to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving being the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder and declaring an emergency was read by title only.

Motion made by Zolata and seconded by Mizesak to suspend the rule requiring the reading of said ordinance on three different days.

The roll was called. Vote – Yeas: Zolata, Batten, Koci, Mizesak, Pocek, Pozar, Saunders. Nays: None. Motion carried unanimously.


Motion made by Saunders and seconded by Pozar to place Ordinance No. **9096-13** on third and final reading and passed.


Mr. Angelo explained this was a 120 day project and the project was limited to Broadway Avenue. Councilman Saunders thought since this was a main travelled street, the truck traffic should be redirected to another route using Northfield, Rockside and Forbes Roads. Councilwoman Mizesak questioned the amount. Mr. Angelo clarified the low bid was corrected by the Engineer to \$1,510,190.00. The Engineer's estimate for this project was \$1,452,250.00.
