### Chipper Service

October is the last month for chipper service. Chipper service will be the week of October 2 through October 6. Have clippings on tree lawn before October 2 and called into the Service Department at 440.735.6583.

### Trick or Treat Safety Tips from the Bedford Police Department:

- ◆ Adults should accompany smaller children. Children who are old enough to trick-or-treat without an adult should stay in a group – there is safety in numbers.
- ◆ Driving next to your children as they are trick or treating is not allowed. It impedes the flow of traffic and makes things more dangerous for the children.
- ◆ Plan a safe route so parents know where their older kids will be at all times. Set a time for their return home. Make sure that your child is old enough and responsible enough to go out by themselves. Make sure that they have a cell phone.
- ◆ Look both ways before crossing the street and cross at street corners. Do not run between parked cars or across lawns and yards where ornaments, furniture or clotheslines present dangers .
- ◆ Instruct your child to never go into the home of a stranger or get into their car. Explain why this is not a good idea and what to do if someone approaches them and tries to talk to them.
- ◆ Make sure your child carries a flashlight, glow stick or has reflective tape on their costume to make them more visible to cars.
- ◆ Remind children not to eat any candy before coming home. Parents should carefully examine all treats for signs of tampering, and discard anything not sealed or in its original packaging.
