Solid Waste District Seminar

The Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District will be holding a free Backyard Composting Seminar and Bin Sale on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.

The informative seminar is designed to teach residents how to properly compost yard waste and food scraps in their backyards while offering low cost compost bins for sale. Backyard composting helps reduce the amount of organic waste sent to landfills while creating a healthy soil additive that can be used in gardens and landscapes.
